CGA/19/31 - Using co-design to mitigate the 'Inverse care law' in rolling out an early detection of lung cancer service

Some groups, like smokers or people exposed to asbestos, are more likely to get lung cancer than others. There is a new blood test that can tell if you are at high risk. We want to see if offering the blood test to these people through the NHS improves their chances of living longer. We know that not everyone makes use of available screening tests. We plan to talk with people and doctors to understand what would help them use the lung cancer test. This will help us develop a service to provide this new way of detecting cancer early.
