## CGA/19/83 - Can co-design enhance national quality improvement interventions

National Clinical Audits are used extensively in the NHS (in both Primary and Secondary Care) as a way of improving the quality of care delivered. However, there is considerable uncertainty about how the design, content and process of clinical audit impacts on its effectiveness, and it is not known what works best and in what circumstances. This project will work with healthcare professionals, patients, and policy stakeholders to co-design two National Clinical Audits to improve the quality of preventive treatments for child dental decay. This work will underpin a UK-wide randomised controlled trial to evaluate the impact of these co-designed audits on the quality of care delivered.
