## HIPS/20/21 – A prospective survey of Near Fatal Asthma in Children and Adolescents to inform future care bundle to reduce risk of death in this population

Asthma is a very common health condition in Scotland, and a number of children and young people have died because of it. Asthma attacks can be different every time and for every person. There is a type of attack which makes it more likely that person will have another attack within a year, and maybe die. These are called "near fatal asthma attacks". Depending on where they live, the care people receive after a 'near fata asthma attack' can be very different. We want that to change. In this study we want to find out:

- 1. how many people have had one of these attacks
- 2. what care they received after the attack
- 3. what happened to them in the following year

We hope the results of this study will:

- a) improve the consistency of care people receive after a near fatal asthma attack
  - b) reduce the number of asthma deaths
